From Eligibility Review to Verified Relief

S365 manages the BICS process from initial assessment through to implementation, verification and ongoing scheme requirements.

The S365 Process

01

ASSESS

Establish your position

Review your business activity, products, sites and electricity usage against the requirements to establish where BICS relief could apply.

02

EVIDENCE

Build the evidence base

Co-ordinate site, grid consumption, metering and manufacturing evidence, including any complex arrangements if required.

03

PREPARE

Develop a complete case

Coordinate the information, calculations and supporting evidence, resolve gaps and prepare the application for submission.

04

SUBMIT

Manage through assessment

Once authorised, S365 manages submission and remains your point of coordination for subsequent questions or evidence requests.

Submission Is Not the Finish Line



IMPLEMENT

Ensure the relief is correctly applied to sites and supplies.



VERIFY

Review invoices against the expected relief and identify any discrepancies.



MAINTAIN

Support ongoing scheme requirements, reviews and relevant business changes.
